2022 NAPLAN Testing

The National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a set of tests undertaken by all students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 across Australia each year in May. The aim of NAPLAN is to highlight the progress that students make over their time at school.

NAPLAN is not a pass or fail style of test. The result of this testing provides information for students, parents, and teachers, which is used to improve student achievement.

This year NAPLAN is being held online. As these tests are now online the testing window has been expanded to a two-week period from 10th May through until 20th May. This will include catch up sessions for absent students.

This week our Year 7 and Year 9 students have started with Writing, Reading and Language Conventions.

Next week they will continue their testing in Numeracy assessments. This has been very successful as all the students have been able to complete their tests without any issues.

Later in the year you will receive your child's personal NAPLAN report.

Winter Concert


