Highvale rewards enthusiastic students who show initiative, leadership and high academic ability. Scholarship recipients benefit from our first class programs and facilities and make a full contribution to College life. The College provides three categories of Scholarships. These are:

Academic Excellence

These scholarships are awarded to Year 6, Year 8 and 10 students each year and are two years in duration. These scholarships support high achieving students for two years. Selection is based upon student academic performance in a scholarship examination in combination with supporting evidence from the student's current and past school history.

Academic Excellence Scholarship applications are invited by 31st August. Testing is conducted in Term 4 for Year 6 students, Year 8 and Year 10 students.

Music

Highvale Secondary College's music program seeks talented and enthusiastic music students to complement its vibrant performance bands and ensembles. Music scholarships are awarded each year to recognise excellence and support students to pursue instrumental music studies. Music scholarships are tenured for a two year period for Year 6 and Year 8 students and one year period for Year 11 and Year 12 students.

Music Scholarships applications are invited by 31st August supported with a folio e.g. certificates of participation and completed Music Scholarship Form demonstrating leadership and experience.

Music Scholarships applications are invited for Year 8 and Year 10 students by the end of Term 3.

Sport

Students who excel in physical activity in a range of sports are recognised through sporting scholarships. Sport Scholarships applications are invited by 31st August supported with a folio e.g. certificates of participation and completed Music Scholarship Form demonstrating leadership and experience.

Sport Scholarships applications are invited for Year 8 and Year 10 students by the end of Term 3. These scholarships are tenured for a one year period.

Successful scholarships recipients are presented to the full school community at the annual Presentation Evening held in December.
