YEAR 10 TEXTBOOK REQUIREMENTS 2025

Dear Parent/Carer/Guardian,

At Highvale Secondary College, families are given two options to supply their students with the required textbooks for the year.

Option A: Participate in our Book Hire Program

Option B: Source and purchase your own textbooks from an external provider

Students are asked to purchase their own English texts (so they can be annotated), own stationery, as well as Languages and Music workbooks – these are not included in the book hire program. Separate listings for these will be provided.

Option A: Book Hire Program

The Book Hire Program was introduced over twenty years ago and has saved parents many thousands of dollars over the years. Under the program, parents are expected to pay an annual service charge. This provides students with an individual copy of relevant texts throughout the year and access to class sets. Parents should note that the textbooks are hired only, and they remain the property of the College. Parents are required to pay for books lost or damaged by students.

The hire fee of **\$250** is designed to cover the cost of buying new books for 2025. Books are replaced as required to keep up to date with the current curriculum. School Council ensures that the Book Hire Program guarantees minimum cost to parents. With textbooks being within the vicinity of \$500 or more per year, there is a significant saving through the HSC Book Hire Program.

This service also saves parents time and the issues of trying to source textbooks for the best price. Families who use our Book Hire Program will not need to be concerned about what to do with Texts Books that they now own, but no longer require. On-selling textbooks can be difficult with a continually changing and updating curriculum, and these texts are often no longer required, or are no longer the most current edition.

If you wish to use this service, please either complete and return the attached book hire form to the college or log on to your compass home page under payment centre to set up your student's book hire arrangement for 2025, which must be completed prior to the collection of textbooks.

Option B: Purchasing

The following texts are provided to students opting to participate in the College Book Hire program. Alternatively, parents may choose to source and purchase their own from an external provider.
